Please note all competition play is conducted under Tennis Australia rules and regulations. These can be accessed on the internet. The sections that all players and supporters need to understand and be familiar with relate to self-umpiring, Code of Conduct, unsportsmanlike conduct, all of which are matters that incur penalties under the rules and regulations.

A few things to note that will help everyone on site know what is happening on court: -

Before each service point call the score loudly and clearly – if there is a discrepancy it can be quickly addressed and resolved while current.

Call the ball out or fault loudly and clearly AFTER the ball has bounced. If you are not sure if the ball is in or out, it is your responsibility to give the opponent the benefit of the doubt and play the ball as in. Spectators are not permitted to offer advice on line calls. There are very few instances when it is acceptable to replay a point.

Please be aware that the word CHEAT is as unacceptable as other swear words. Any audible utterances or where balls are hit in anger or players lose control of their racquet is unacceptable behaviour.

When short games are being played, become familiar with “Receivers Choice” when the score reaches DEUCE.

It is required that the server have possession of 2 balls before serving. The rule is “play must be continuous”, this is not possible if the server has to chase a ball for the second serve. If the first serve is a fault do not return it, let it go to the fence.

Players, who suffer a medical episode on court during a set, have one medical time out of 10 minutes. If unable to resume at the end of 10 minutes the set is forfeited.

BTI will review infringements with penalties ranging from loss of match points to suspension from competition.

Semi-finals 1st V 4th and 2nd v 3rd All divisions – venue to be advised.

All teams who do not qualify for semi-finals, or additional team member, any parents and friends will be invited to participate in a social fun round robin on semi-final day. Venue will be notified.

*****Please note

To ensure as much play as possible is achieved in all divisions during the scheduled matches, when a team is unable to field a full team, all doubles will be played as cut-throat sets. Two players against 1. The player without a partner will play into the doubles court but the 2 players can only play into the singles court. Please check with the venue supervisor for clarification. The single player will serve every alternate game. (Not available for semi or final matches, full team to be fielded or sets forfeited)

In a further effort to minimise teams turning up without the required number of players, at-fault teams will not be eligible for the 4 bonus match points that are awarded to the team winning on games. Match points will not automatically divert to the losing team.

Registration & court fees Division 1 Team fee \$300.00 (Maximum of 3 players @ \$100.00 each)

Division 2 & Below Team fee \$210.00. (Minimum of 2 players @ \$105.00 each or if 3 players, \$70.00 each.)

All competition players (permanent and reserves) must be a member of Blacktown Tennis Inc. (BTI)

Court hire is included in the registration fee. All fees must be paid within 14 days of the commencement of the comp.

Teams that are fully financial, may play an additional player without additional registration, however that player must be a BTI member for the financial year the competition is being played in.

BTI Membership for the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019 is due before the end of June. Adult \$50.00 and Junior under 18 years \$35.00

Teams forfeiting without good reason will be penalised by the loss of 2 competition points. The BTI Management Committee will review appeals lodged in writing on payment of \$5.00 application fee.

SATURDAY AFTERNOON MIXED

3 PLAYERS – Division 1

Matches shall consist of Six (6) tiebreak sets with the tiebreak game at 6 games all.

Each player shall participate in three (2) Doubles sets and (1) Singles Set.

Players within a team are graded, with each player competing against the opponents corresponding number.

e.g. Doubles 1 & 2 -v- 1 & 2

1 & 3 -v- 1 & 3

2 & 3 -v- 2 & 3

Singles 1 -v- 1, 2 -v- 2 3 -v- 3

No person shall play with the same partner in more than one (1) set.

The seeding order played in the third match of the competition may not be altered for the remainder of the competition without approval of the Competition Secretary. When higher graded player/s do not take part in a match, borrowed or pool players must

be played in their order of ability within the team. At all times players will play in the order determined from the 3rd match. Where seeds are played out of order, or in the opinion of the Competition Committee following protest, borrowed or pool players are incorrectly seeded, points may be deducted, and/or sets forfeit. **NOTE:** No player can participate in two (2) matches on the same day unless appropriate explanation given. Please also note a team without sufficient players will be required to play the doubles as cut-throat sets. Points will be allocated for these sets.

Commencement time of match 1 PM

Finishing time is no later than 5pm. Finish the game in play at 5pm; record the result & share points for undecided or unfinished sets. The Association will allocate one (1) point for each set won and four (4) points for winning on games - if games are even, bonus points to team with most sets, if games & sets are even the points are shared.

Home Team shall be the first mentioned in the draw.

The server in the first set shall be decided on a toss and the service shall alternate in subsequent sets.

Set put on. The Visiting Team shall put on the 1st, 3rd & 5th sets. The Home Team shall put on the 2nd, 4th sets.

Claiming Forfeits: Teams who do not have a pair ready to play at the stipulated time must forfeit a set. On expiration of ten (10) minutes the second set can be claimed, and at intervals of ten (10) minutes subsequent sets can be claimed until the end of the fifth set, when the match can be claimed.

Result Cards – Please make sure full **Given and Surnames** are written next the seeding numbers on the card and record singles result next to full name. Card must be completed and signed by both captains. It is the responsibility of the winning Team to forward the card to the Competition Secretary within 48 hours of the match being played. Cards may be left at either of the Association Centres.

A maximum of four (4) trophies will be awarded to teams participating in the final.

2 Player teams

All rules regarding starting time etc as for above.

All games have been changed to second deuce sudden death. This means that the scoring in a game may require deuce to be reached twice in a game. Eg from deuce, advantage, deuce, then game point which will be receiver choice at the second deuce call. The receiver may elect which side the game point is to be served to.

Match consists of 1 Doubles, first to 8 games (tie break at 7 all. & 4 singles first to 6 with tiebreak at 5 all.

Seeding is not necessary as each person plays 1singles against both opponents.

Suggested order of play - 1 pro-set doubles, 2 singles & 2 reverse singles

Please start promptly at 1 PM – no more than 3 minutes between sets & you will have plenty of time to complete matches. No warm ups after all players have played 1 set each.

In Division 1 – One (1) point is allocated for each set won, with 4 bonus points for the most games in completed matches (except when a team is a player short).

In division 2 and below – Two (2) points are allocated for the Doubles and One (1) point for each of the singles. Four (4) bonus points are allocated to the team with most games in completed matches.

Match and set point will be shared if match is not completed.
